Mrs Ketevan Tsikhelashvili has been State Minister of Georgia for Reconciliation and Civic Equality since 2016. Prior to her appointment, she held the position of the deputy State Minister. She also was Chairwoman of the Georgian National Platform at the Eastern Partnership Civil Society Forum. In addition, she was Founding Director of the think tank Foundation Liberal Academy-Tbilisi. She holds degrees from the Central European University, Budapest and from the Tbilisi State University. The Office of the State Minister for Reconciliation and Civic Equality is a government agency within the Cabinet of Ministers of Georgia. It is in charge of coordinating the policy of peaceful conflict resolution, particularly reconciliation and engagement with Abkhazian and Ossetian communities living in the occupied territories of Georgia.
