- Prestige for the presenters, as well as for their fields of study and institutes
- Extra points towards course credits for students taking English

WHAT TOPICS ARE SUITABLE AND APPROPRIATE

Any topic related to the contestant's field of study The presentation should be understandable for students and teachers from other fields. Ideally it should convince the audience about the attractiveness of studying at the represented institute

Only one particular topic or issue should be dealt with, not presentation of an outline of the field or a list of subjects provided by a given institute

LENGTH OF PRESENTATION

5 - 7 minutes

5 minutes questions from the audience and judges

VISUAL AIDS

No specific visual aid is prescribed, any functional, legal, and commonly used electronic software may be used such as PowerPoint or Prezi

Handouts or even using no visual aid is also a possibility

Formal to semi-formal
